



Statement of Cooperation

1. We understand that an active pursuit of a deeper relationship with Christ is one of the qualifications for admission to CCA. We commit to faithfully attend church, to train our children according to Biblical principles, and to model a growing faith. We understand that our child(ren) may become disqualified for enrollment if we falter in these commitments.
2. We will endeavor to support the principles, practices, and educational policies of the school in every way.
3. We grant permission to school authorities to discipline our child(ren) with the procedures that are outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook. We further agree to accept the school's judgment in such matters and will cooperate with them.
4. We understand that the fees and tuition do not cover the actual cost of educating our child(ren). Therefore, we agree to willingly contribute prayer and service for the school and assist in publicizing the school among our friends.
5. We recognize that it is essential that our child(ren) have confidence in his/her teachers and school. Therefore, we will do all in our power to see that our child(ren) respects and obeys the school staff and rules. We will cooperate in training our child(ren) to respect school property and will correct any willful damage or defacing of such property done by our child(ren).
6. We understand that the administration of the school has the final responsibility for the grade placement of our child(ren). We agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of CCA. We will see that our child(ren) reaches school on time with any necessary slips signed and returned. We will provide our child(ren) with a place to study and will encourage him/her in the completion of any assignment or homework. We agree to attend parent/teacher conferences and work with the teachers to ensure our child(ren)'s academic success.
7. We understand that it is crucial to the long-term success of CCA that any criticism be solution-oriented. We agree that if our child(ren) should become involved in any trouble or we disagree with any policy set by the school, we will in no case complain or talk poorly about CCA to any other party or in the presence of students (conversations, social media, email, etc.). Instead, in the spirit of meekness, we will register only necessary complaints with the teacher or administrator involved. (Matthew 18:15-17)
8. I understand that if at any time the school determines, in its sole discretion, that my actions do not support the ministry, or that they reflect a lack of commitment to the home and school working together, the school has the right to request the withdrawal of my child(ren).
